**PRESENTATION SUMMARY:**

Bill thanked the citizen advisory committee for the opportunity to present updates on the Water Authority's projects that relate to Mission Trails Park. He introduced the presenters and staff present. Craig provided a brief presentation on the Mission Trails Project. He described the project components that include a nearly 1-mile long pipeline tunnel, flow regulatory structure II, removal for nine of the ten existing vent structures, an improved San Diego River crossing, and a interconnection at Shepherd Wye near the Belsera community. He also announced that the 60 percent project design should be completed by early 2007. Construction should begin in late 2007 and end in late 2009.
