

# Notice to our Via Promesa Neighbors

October 2008



Starting this week, you may notice work commencing at the east end of Clairemont Mesa Boulevard for the San Diego County Water Authority's Mission Trails Project.

The Water Authority's contractor, L.H. Woods & Sons, Inc., will begin setting up temporary field office trailers. This location at the east end of Clairemont Mesa Boulevard will be the primary project access point for construction vehicles and equipment and will host the construction field offices.

The contractor's work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Saturday. The project is scheduled to be complete in mid-2011.

## Trail Closures Begin

For safety reasons, recreational trail access will only be allowed on Sundays and before 7 a.m. and after 7 p.m. most other days along the northern Clairemont Mesa Boulevard sidewalk.

When the contractor begins working in Mission Trails Regional Park, other trails in the western portion of the park will be closed. The Mission Trails Project will upgrade critical water pipelines running beneath western portions of Mission Trails Regional Park, improving water reliability and increasing the amount of water delivered to treatment plants serving the central and south sections of the county.
