

# Paint Mountain Pipeline Relining Starting Fall 2007

**Overview:** The San Diego County Water Authority must reline a section of the aging concrete pipe along the Water Authority's easement with steel. The Paint Mountain Pipeline Relining Project ensures a safe and reliable water supply for the region by extending the life of the pipe up to 75 years. Most of the work will be conducted through a tunneling process, making it less obtrusive for the community.

**Where:** This project will take place along the Water Authority's Aqueduct easement. It begins immediately **north of Del Dios Highway in Rancho Santa Fe** (east of Rancho Santa Fe Drive) and **continues north to Paint Mountain** (Fortuna Del Este).

**When:** **Fall 2007 - summer 2008**  
Look for detailed notices this summer once construction plans are finalized. Between now and fall 2007, Water Authority personnel and contractors may access the easement periodically during the day to survey the area.
