Dear Neighbor,

This letter is intended to provide helpful information about a construction project in your neighborhood that will require some temporary traffic lane closures.

In July or early August, the San Diego County Water Authority will begin work on the Ramona Pipeline Cathodic Protection Project. The Ramona Pipeline is located under Rancho Bernardo Road and Espola Road. The contractor will avoid commuting hours whenever possible by scheduling most work Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The project will be complete by spring 2008.

Cathodic protection will extend the life of the Ramona Pipeline, which provides water to homes and businesses in Rancho Bernardo and portions of the city of Poway. The Water Authority's contractor will install cathodic protection devices at 10 locations along Rancho Bernardo Road and Espola Road. Cathodic protection will slow the corrosion process and protect the pipeline from deterioration.

The Water Authority will notify nearby residents and businesses before construction begins at each of the 10 sites. Oversized postcards or door hangers will be distributed as construction nears to provide information that will be helpful during the project. Enclosed is a fact sheet that provides more detail about the Ramona Pipeline Project, and a map showing the 10 project sites.
