Work on the San Diego County Water Authority's water treatment plant in Twin Oaks Valley has begun. CH2M HILL is the designer, builder, and operator of the plant. This month, CH2M HILL has been establishing field offices for construction management staff and preparing the site for grading. Grading is scheduled to begin during the week of Jan. 23 and to continue through March. Storm water pollution prevention measures to control run-off have been installed and will be enhanced as the project develops. The uninhabited house on the project site will be demolished soon.

The water treatment plant must be constructed and placed in service by April 2008. Regular work hours for the project are 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. On occasion, CH2M HILL will extend the workday to as late as 7 p.m., and some work may be scheduled on an occasional Saturday. These extended work hours will be planned only when necessary to keep the project on schedule and must be approved by the Water Authority in advance.

All work activities during extended hours and on Saturdays will comply with the provisions in the project EIR. The Water Authority and CH2M HILL will work hard to avoid the need for extended hours, and will minimize disturbances to the community when extended hours are necessary.
