**SCOPE OF WORK:**

The Water Authority is seeking proposals from qualified firms for professional services to complete the evaluation and design of a 50-acre sport fishery mitigation pond at the identified pond site within the California Department of Fish and Game's Wister Management Area. The project site is located in Imperial County, on the southeast edge of the Salton Sea, Thomas Guide Page 411, B-7, near the intersection of Davis Road and Ruddy Road. The pond is intended to be stocked with various sport fishing species including bass, catfish, and sunfish, and will be open to the general public for shoreline sport fishing purposes.
