Project Update

The Mission Trails Project, which was scheduled to begin in late 2007, has been delayed to this summer to obtain necessary property and easements for construction. The major elements of the Mission Trails Project include constructing an underground water tank, a tunneled pipeline, and a stabilized river crossing at the San Diego River.

The project will help ensure water reliability in the region through the year 2030. For the most up-to-date project and schedule information, please check the Mission Trails Project webpage at missiontrails.sdcwa.org.
