He currently sits on the Administrative and Finance Committee and the Legislation and Public Outreach Committee. He also is a member of the MWD Settlement Negotiations Team and the chair of the Colorado River Work Group. In addition, Croucher is the Water Authority's alternate to the San Diego Association of Governments Board of Directors and to SANDAG's Borders Committee.

Croucher is a long-time firefighter in San Diego. He is the Assistant Chief for CAL Fire/San Diego County fire and during his 30-year career as a firefighter has moved up the ranks from Firefighter, Engineer, Captain and Battalion Chief to his current position of Assistant Chief. He was previously the San Diego County Fire Districts representative to Homeland Security and he continues as terrorism liaison officer for the region. He was appointed to the Otay Water District's Board in 2001 by the County Board of Supervisors and following his appointment was elected four times to the Division 3 seat. He has served as President of the Otay Water District Board three times, and as Chair of its various committees. He has also served as the Water Authority alternate to the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG), and serves on the Local Agency Formation Commission's (LAFCO) Special District Advisory Committee.

His career is highlighted with many accomplishments, including being named Employee of the Year and serving as the President of the Executive Board of Directors for Southern Area Fire Equipment Research (SAFER) in 2004.
