The first phase of the Mission Trails Project, construction of the pipeline tunnel, is proceeding well. The south tunnel connection is complete and pipeline installation is now ready to begin.

Beginning this week and continuing through November, three additional large trucks will deliver pipe sections to the South Portal each day using the Calle de Vida entry point to the park. This is in addition to the existing construction traffic in the area. In November, the number of trucks needing to deliver pipe sections may increase to up to five per day. To protect trail users and safeguard ingress and egress for trucks, the nearby trail off Calle de Vida will be temporarily closed during the pipe deliveries.

Construction completion of the Mission Trails Pipeline Tunnel project is anticipated for June 2011. In mid-2011, the construction of an underground flow regulatory structure is scheduled to begin as part of the second phase of the Mission Trails Project.
